Katerina Haidopoulou MD, Phd, HERMES ERS Diplomate is Professor of Paediatrics & Paediatric Respiratory Medicine at the School of Medicine of the Aristotle University in Thessaloniki, Greece. She completed her undergraduate degree in Medicine at the School of Medicine of the Aristotle University and undertook her clinical specialist training in Paediatrics at the 4th Pediatric Department, University Hospital AHEPA, Thessaloniki. She received her Doctoral Degree at the School of Medicine of the Aristotle University investigating the pathology of childhood asthma.

She teaches to undergraduate medical students and to postgraduate students of the PPS "Research Methodology in Medicine and in Health Sciences", School of Medicine, Aristotle University and the PPS "Pediatric Pulmonology" of the Medical School of the National and Kapodestrial University of Athens and has been awarded a Commendation of Excellence in the Teaching of the School of Health Sciences, Aristotle University.

Her research interests focus on respiratory conditions that affect children including preschool wheeze, asthma, chest infections and lung disease in neuromuscular diseases. She participates in several committees of the School of Medicine (Doctoral Dissertation Committee, Erasmus Committee as coordinator of Erasmus ECTS studies for incoming students, Internal Evaluation Committee) and the Quality Assurance Unit (MODIP) as coordinator for the Pediatrics Course. She is a member of 8 Greek and 3 international Scientific - Medical Societies and served as Vice President (elected) of the Hellenic Pediatric Pulmonary Society (2011-2019). She is a member of the Examination Committee for the acquisition of the European Diploma in Pediatric Pulmonology (HERMES European Examination in Pediatric Respiratory Medicine).
