George Giannakoulas, MD, PhD runs the Adult Congenital Heart Disease and Pulmonary Hypertension Clinics at the AHEPA University Hospital in Thessaloniki, Greece. He is an Associate Professor in Cardiology and Adult Congenital Heart Disease at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He runs numerous international clinical trials on heart failure and pulmonary hypertension. Dr Giannakoulas has spent most of his professional career in Thessaloniki, with a 2-year fellowship at the Royal Brompton Hospital in London. He is currently the President-Elect of the Working Group on Pulmonary Circulation and Right Ventricular Function of the European Society of Cardiology and he serves as the National ESC Guidelines Coordinator of the Hellenic Cardiological Society and the National Coordinator for the Adult Congenital Heart Disease (CHALLENGE) registry. Dr Giannakoulas' research activities are mainly focused on pulmonary hypertension, congenital heart disease and heart failure. He has published 230 scientific publications indexed in Pubmed (7271 citations, h-factor=32, May 2021), has been a reviewer for high impact journals and serves as an Associate Editor in Hellenic Journal of Cardiology, European Journal of Preventive Cardiology and International Journal of Cardiology Congenital Heart Disease. In 2016, students of the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki rated him as the second best Teacher of the Year.
