In 1989 I entered the Medical school of Aristotle University after National examinations. I completed my studies in 6 years taking the Degree of the Medical School of Thessaloniki, Greece in 1995. I did my compulsory rural service as a Doctor in a Health Center and military service between 1996-1999.

Afterwards I started my Residency in Otorhinolaryngology as follows:

1 year of General Surgery in Theageneio Anticancer Institute of Thessaloniki, Greece and

AHEPA University Hospital Thessaloniki, Greece

1 year ORL in United Kingdom (East Glasgow and East Kent NHS trusts)

3 years ORL in Hippokratio General Hospital Thessaloniki Greece

I passed the examinations of Greek CCST (Certification of Specialist) in 2004. The same year I got the Prize for young researchers of the International Rhinological Society (2004). I used this fellowship for 6 months specialization in Rhinology at the ORL Department of Dresden Medical School, Germany.

I completed my PhD in 2006 at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Olfactory mucosa in nasal obstruction) resulting in 3 publications.

In 2008 I got the post-doctoral prize of Aristotle University for International research collaboration in retronasal olfaction (1 publication).

Between 2005-2006 I worked as a young ORL Specialist in two District Hospitals (Kavala and Veria) and then I took the position of ORL Specialist/NHS in the 2nd Academic ORL Department of Aristotle University in Papageorgiou Hospital in which I worked for 6 years.

I was elected Lecturer in ORL of Aristotle University and I was appointed in the same Department in 2012.

In 2012 I completed a 2 years International Diploma in Otolaryngology Rhinology and Skull base surgery (Transmedeast).

In 2015 I was elected Assistant Professor and in 2020 I was elected Associate Professor in ORL of Aristotle University with continuous work in the same department.

In 2017 I completed a mini fellowship of two months in Pediatric Otolaryngology in the academic ORL department of University of Lausanne Switzerland and two months in Rhinology at the academic ORL department of St Luc Brussels University.

Between 2004-11 I also attended 4 short travelling fellowships in recognized centers abroad for:

1. Minimally invasive techniques in Salivary gland diseases in the Academic ORL Dept. of Erlangen Germany (Prof Iro) (2weeks)
2. External approaches for paranasal tumours in Sourasky Hospital, Tel Aviv, Israel (Prof Fliss) (1 week)
3. Pediatric airway management Royal Hospital for Sick Children Glasgow, UK (Mr Kubba) (2 weeks)
4. Research in intranasal trigeminal function, Academic ORL Dept. of Dresden Germany (Prof Hummel). (2weeks)

In my current position I am running three special clinics (Sialendoscopy clinic, Smell and taste clinic and Rhinology clinic) with the first two being unique in the Greek NHS.

I participate in 5 research international and national multicentric research projects. I have 78 publications in peer reviewed journals, >1200 citations and an H-factor of 19.

I also wrote two chapters in International Rhinology books, one chapter in an International Salivary glands book and two booklets in Greek about Nasal airway and Objective methods of assessment in Rhinology.

My teaching experience includes medical students, dental students and postgraduate students of Aristotle (Thessaloniki) and Democritus (Alexandroupolis) Universities since 2007. I have >100 lectures in Seminars, Courses and Congresses with 36 lectures as invited speaker in 13 countries abroad.

I am a member of ISOANA the International Standards Organization for the Assessment of the upper (Nasal) Airways which is a task force of the European and the International Rhinologic Societies committee, establishing guidelines for the assessment of all nasal functions. I am also member of Clinical Olfactory Working Group a working group on chemical senses of European Rhinologic Society. I was elected twice in the board of Greek ORL Society, four times in the board of ORL Society of Northern Greece and I am founding member of the Greek Salivary Gland Society (General Secretary). I have been also the General Secretary of the Greek Rhinological Society for 5 years.
