Nikolaos Foroglou, MD, PhD has graduated from the *School of Medicine of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki* in 1993 with the mention “excellent”. After his military service in the Hellenic Air Force General Hospital (1993-1995) and a community medical service in the highlands of North Greece (1995-1996) he obtained the *Diploma of Clinical Neurology* from the Institute of Neurology (UCL) at the National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery, Queen Square. Thereafter he completed the *Residency Program* in the Neurosurgical Department, *AHEPA University Hospital* (1997-2001) and received his PhD degree from the same University. After being certified from the *National Neurosurgical Examination Board*, and the *European Association of Neurosurgical Societies* (EANS) in 2001, he completed a *research fellowship on neuro-oncology* (Brigham & Women Hospital, affiliated hospital Harvard Medical School). At that time, he was introduced in modern surgical neuro-oncology (multi-disciplinary approach, intraoperative imaging (MRI), intraoperative monitoring, awake craniotomy) and completed a research project concerning the long-term survival of malignant primary brain tumours. In 2002, he did a *fellowship in Functional Neurosurgery* (epilepsy, movement disorders, pain, and spasticity) and *Paediatric Neurosurgery* in the University Hospital of Lausanne, Switzerland.

He was elect unanimously as Lecturer of Neurosurgery in 2003 at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Assistant Professor in 2010, Associated Professor in 2016 and Professor in 2020. He is currently appointed at the Department of Neurosurgery, AHEPA University Hospital. His clinical and research activity are focused on neuro-oncology and epilepsy surgery. He developed different neuroendoscopic techniques, intraoperative imaging, and intraoperative neurophysiology, he is leading research programs on brain mapping and on gliomas, and he is participating in international research projects on epilepsy and brain plasticity. He visited 3 European Neurosurgical Departments (National Hospital/London in 1996, Gui de Chuliac/Montpellier in 2007 and 2010, Grosshadern LMU/Munich in 2009). He has published 117 peer reviewed papers, h-index 13, authored 13 chapters book and presented more than 200 lectures. <https://orcid.org/0000-0003-3660-6293>
