Panagiotis Ioannidis graduated from Medical School at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (A.U.TH.) in 1992, obtained his residency in Neurology in 2001 and his specialization in dementia at the Dementia research group, National Hospital for Neurology, University College London in 2002. He received his PhD from A.U.TH. in 2006. He was appointed to the position of Lecturer in Neurology, at the University's teaching hospital, Ahepa in 2009. He is currently an Associate Professor of Neurology at the Medical School of A.U.TH., B' Dept of Neurology, AHEPA University Hospital responsible for the Outpatient Dementia and relevant disorders clinic and has focused his interest on neurodegenerative diseases and rare neurological disorders. He is also a member of the Thessaloniki Medical Association since 1993, of the American Academy of Neurology since 2000, of the British Medical Association since 2001 and a founder member of Hellenic Academy of Neuroimmunology. His research has been published in 78 publications in peer-review scientific Journals, with 660 citations and H-index = 14.
