Emmanuel Roilides, MD, PhD, FIDSA, FAAM, FESCMID, FECMM, FISAC is Professor of Paediatrics – Infectious Diseases in Aristotle University School of Medicine at Hippokration Hospital in Thessaloniki, Greece. He received his medical and doctor of philosophy degrees from the University of Athens in Greece, and worked for seven years at the National Institutes of Health (National Child Health and Cancer Institutes) in Bethesda, Maryland, USA. Since 1993, Professor Roilides has been a faculty member in the Aristotle University School of Medicine. He currently directs the research laboratory as well as the Division of Infectious Diseases of the 3rd Department of Pediatrics. He is Board member of the Special Unit for Biomedical Research and Education of the School of Medicine and representative of its Basic and Translational Research Unit. His research interests focus on serious infections in children such as fungal infections and multi-resistant Gram-negative bacteria. Professor Roilides is on the Editorial Board of several international biomedical journals. He is the author of more than 620 peer reviewed articles and book chapters (>420 in PUBMED) that have had a number of >24000 citations (Google Scholar h-index: 80). He has contributed as co-ordinator or as partner in several multicentre or multinational studies.
