Dr Sardeli received her MD from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 1996 and her PhD in Pharmacology from the same University in 2002. She worked in Denmark from 1998-2006 as a research assistant, a clinical teacher, and a postgraduate fellow at University of Aarhus, where she also specialized in Obstetrics-Gynaecology in Skejby University Hospital and Randers Central Hospital (2000-2006).

Upon her return to Greece, she was appointed a Lecturer in Pharmacology and currently serves as an Associate Professor of Pharmacology-Clinical Pharmacology at the Department of Clinical Pharmacology of the School of Medicine, Faculty of Health Sciences, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.

She is a member of ENTIS (European Network of Teratology Information Services) and HeaLab (a European network researching and publishing on medical law and bioethics). In her academic work, she focuses on pharmacology, clinical pharmacology and bioethics teaching and training on an under- and postgraduate level. She collaborates mostly with surgical specialists to provide the best available pharmacotherapies to their patients and to secure a high level of patient adherence to pharmacotherapy as well as minimizing risks that arise from use of medicines in every day medical practice and as well as in clinical trials. In her role as Ethics Expert, she assesses research proposals on a national and European level (at the Directorate General for Research and Innovation, European Commission), she consults on research proposals and teaches and publishes on bioethics, medical ethics and research ethics.
