Chryssa Pourzitaki graduated from School of Medicine of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 2003. She has Postgraduate Degrees in "Medical Research Methodology" as well as in "Health Unit Management" and a PhD in "Pharmacology". Since 2014 she is an Assistant Professor of Clinical Pharmacology at the Laboratory of Clinical Pharmacology of School of Medicine in Aristotle University and at the same time she worked as an Anesthesiologist at the ICU of Clinical Anesthesiology and Intensive Care of AHEPA University Hospital. Her research interests focus on Basic and Clinical Neuropharmacology and Pharmacoepidemiology. She is a member of the Hellenic Society of Basic and Clinical Pharmacology, the British Pharmacological Society, the Hellenic Society of Anesthesiology and the Society of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care of Northern Greece. She participated as a member of the Committee of the National Medicines Agency (EOF) for Unique Medicines, where she is responsible for the clinical evaluation of medicines. In addition, she has worked as a Clinical Investigator in various multicentred clinical studies of pharmaceutical and scientific companies, while she has received research scholarships from the Research Committee of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and the National Research Council of Norway and participated as a researcher in the research programs FP7 and Pythagoras.
