Stella Stabouli is Associate Professor of Pediatrics-Pediatric Nephrology at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece. She received her Medical and Doctoral Degree at the National and Kapodestrial University of Athens, and continued her training in Hypertension and Nephrology at the University of Mississippi Medical Centre and the Nephrology Department of Boston Children's Hospital in USA. She is Vice-President of the the European Society Hypertension working group on Blood Pressure in Children and Adolescents and Board Member of the European Society of Pediatric Nephrology CKD-MBD working group. She is working in the field of pediatric hypertension, obesity, and cardiovascular health in the general pediatric population, as well as pediatric patients with chronic kidney disease and kidney transplantation. Her research activities focus on different blood pressure measurements and their role on the prediction of adverse subclinical outcomes in early childhood and adolescence. She is participating in the Core Group of the HyperChildNET Cost action, which is the 1st multidisciplinary European network on BP in children and adolescents. She is a member of the Editorial Board of scientific journals in the field of pediatric nephrology and hypertension and she has authored more than 100 scientific publications with more than 2,500 citations.
