## Scientific Contributions

Dimitrios Chatzidimitriou MD, PhD, Associate Professor in the Aristotle's University of Thessaloniki Department of Microbiology and Head of the AIDS National Reference Center of Northern Greece. I received my MD in 1996 and my PhD in 2008 from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Medical School. I was specialized in Medical Biopathology in 2005. I completed my postdoctoral fellowship at Johns Hopkins University in 2009. In 2014 I was appointed as a Lecturer of Medical Biopathology-Microbiology in Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and from 2015 I took over the Scientific Direction of the AIDS National Reference Centre of Northern Greece. The same year I was appointed Assistant Professor and in 2020 Associate Professor of Medical Biopathology-Microbiology/Virology. I participate in many national projects as a lead investigator and my main scientific interest focus on infectious diseases and the investigation of the host immune response to viruses that cause human infections particularly HIV, HPV, HBV, HCV, and on molecular epidemiology of viruses. I have been invited speaker in 39 and participated as a chair in 10 conferences. I have also won 3 prizes for the best announcement in National conferences. I have also won a state scholarship (IKY) for PhD in Clinical Microbiology, two scholarships and two excellent awards from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki as well as an ESCMID grant. I have participated as an author in four Chapter books and in 79 peer review publications, h index 11 (scopus). I serve as a General Secretary of Hellenic Society of Virology, from 2017.
