Professor Dinas is a certified Obstetrician-Gynecologist, with a special interest in gynecological oncology and breast surgery. He is Professor and Head of the 2nd Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Medical School, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, located at Hippokration General Hospital.

Under his administration the department got in 2018 accreditation from EBCOG as a certified training center in Obstetrics and Gynecology, and in 2020 from ESGO as a training center in Gynecologic Oncology.

He is the president of the greek Institute of Gynecologic Oncology and Mastology which organized in the last 4 years 10 medical Workshops and Congresses and helps young specialists to gain post-training experience in Obstetrics and Gynecology by funding their academic posts.

He graduated from the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 1991.

He speaks fluently English and German.

He has authored more than 90 publications in international medical journals, edited 4 medical books and wrote more than 50 chapters in medical books.
