Dr Elisavet Georgiou graduated from the School of Medicine, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 1997. She completed her internship in Haematology in 2006 and her PhD Thesis also in 2006 (thesis' title: "Evaluation of *p16* promoter methylation in lung cancer as a biomarker for early diagnosis."). She worked as a visiting researcher in the Centre for Haematology, Imperial College in London, UK from 10/2008 to 8/2009.

During 2008-2014 she worked as a Consultant Haematologist in "Papageorgiou" Hospital, Thessaloniki, Greece. In 2014 she became a member of the AUSoM Faculty, being appointed in the Laboratory of Biological Chemistry, initially as a Lecturer (8/2014-10/2016) and consequently as an Assistant Professor of Medical Biochemistry (10/2016 -today).

Dr Georgiou's research interests include epigenetic regulation of gene expression (DNA methylation, histone modifications, non-coding RNAs) in health and disease. They are associated, through translational research, with the evaluation of diagnostic/prognostic/pathogenetic markers in malignant and non-malignant human diseases. Being experienced in molecular techniques, she has helped and guided MSc and PhD students through the use and troubleshooting of numerous techniques.

Dr Georgiou is author/co-author in 28 articles in peer-reviewed journals (h-index 8), and one book chapter (international editors).
