Dr. Nikolaos Anastasopoulos, MD, PhD, is an Assistant Professor of Anatomy and Surgical Anatomy, School of Medicine, Faculty of Health Sciences at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH). He graduated from the Medical School of AUTH in 1989, gained full qualification as specialist in Orthopaedic Surgery in 1999 and attained the PhD degree in 2007. In 2009 he was appointed as a Lecturer at the Department of Anatomy and Surgical Anatomy and in 2015 he was appointed as an Assistant Professor.

Postgraduate Studies:

1. 3rd Postgraduate Program for Prehospital Trauma and Life Support, organized by the National Instand Aid Center (1997-1998)
2. At 2011 he Joined and successfully certified as an Instructor at the ATLS (Advanced Trauma Life Support) course, organized by the American College of Surgeons.

His research and scientific fields generally include surgical anatomy of the musculoskeletal system, entrapment syndromes of nerves and neuropathies, gross anatomy, topographical anatomy, sports medicine, trauma treatment and life support.

Dr. Nikolaos Anastasopoulos teaches Anatomy to both undergraduate and postgraduate students since 2003. Lectures to undergraduate students are mainly on gross, topographic and functional anatomy in various teaching programs of AUTH addressing mainly medical, dental and pharmaceutical students. He also taught orthopaedic surgery in Nursing School between 1996 and 1999.

His postgraduate teaching subjects from 2003 until today consist of surgical and functional anatomy and advanced trauma life support in postgraduate courses for several organizations such as Sports Medicine Association of Greece, Association of Orthopaedics and

Traumatology of Macedonia and Thrace, the Department of Anatomy and Surgical Anatomy of AUTH and American College of Surgeons (Hellenic Chapter). He also taught through the EPEAK program, “Basics of Systems Morphology and Anatomy”, to a Medical Informatics postgraduate program in AUTH from 2009 until today.

Dr. Nikolaos Anastasopoulos has been a member of the advisory board of many PhD thesis and mastertations. Dr. Anastasopoulos has been a member of the Executive Committee of the “Sports Medicine Association of Greece” between 2004 and 2007. He served as Secretary General of the “Sports Medicine Association of Greece”. He served also as a member of the Scientific Commission of the Federation Internationale de Medicine du Sport-International Federation of Sports Medicine (FIMS).

Dr. Nikolaos Anastasopoulos has published a total of 36 full papers published in international scientific peer review journals indexed in prominent indexes such as indexes of PubMed and Scopus, between 2006 and 2021. His published papers in English are mainly on both clinical and surgical anatomy and orthopaedic surgery. Dr. Nikolaos Anastasopoulos citation index is 198 and h-index is calculated 8 at the Scopus data base system. Dr. Anastasopoulos has also 10 published full text articles in Greek journals. He wrote one chapter titled “Anatomical differences between adult and children skeleton” in an Orthopaedic book.

He is member of Editorial Advisory Board of two international peer-reviewed journal and one national peer-reviewed journal. Dr. Nikolaos Anastasopoulos served as reviewer in 8 international peer reviewed journals and 1 Greek peer-reviewed journal and he is a member in six scientific societies.
