I graduated in 1994 from the University of Ioannina, Medical School (Medical Doctor, MD). My postgraduation studies include: a Certificate in Emergency Pre-hospital Care (1999), a Master of Public Health, from the Harvard School of Public Health, USA (2002), a Certificate in Humanitarian Studies from Harvard University in association with MIT and Tufts University (2002), and a Certificate in the “Governance and financial management of health care institutions” University of Macedonia (2004).

I completed my Residency in Pediatrics in 2004 in the Infectious Diseases Hospital and the 4<sup>th</sup> Department of Pediatrics of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. My subspecialty training in Pediatric Hematology Oncology included 2 years in the Pediatric Oncology Department at Ippokraton Hospital (Thessaloniki, 2007-2009), 2 years in the Pediatric Oncology Department at the Pediatric Oncology Hospital “Elpida” – “P. & A. Kyriakou Children’s Hospital” in (Athens, 2011-2013), and a 1.5 year fellowship in Pediatric Hematology, Oncology and Bone Marrow Transplantation at Great Ormond Street Hospital (London, UK, 2013-2014).

I have performed research in Pediatric Infectious Diseases with Professor E. Roilides (AUTH, 1999-2001) and in the Epidemiology and causation of childhood cancer with Professor E. Petridou (University of Athens, 2009-2010). Finally, in 2018-2019 I was awarded a fellowship in pediatric neuro-oncology and pediatric oncology drug development with Prof. Darren Hargrave (University College London, UK).

I was elected and appointed Lecturer of Pediatrics in 2014 and in 2016 I was elected Assistant Professor of Pediatrics-Pediatric Hematology/Oncology. I have co-authored 46 articles in peer-reviewed international journals (H-index: 17, >900 citations), 5 chapters in medical textbooks and I have translated books and chapters of medical books from English into Greek. I am a reviewer in several medical journals and member of the Editorial Board of an International Pediatric Oncology Journal. I am a member of several international scientific pediatric oncology societies.
