Stergios Polyzos received his Medical Diploma (MD; 1996), Master in Science (MSc in Medical Research Technology; 2004) and Doctor of Philosophy (PhD; 2012) degrees from the School of Medicine, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), Greece. He received a Pedagogical and Teaching degree (BSc; 2002) from the School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (SELETE) of Thessaloniki, Greece. He also completed the specialization in Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism at Endocrine Clinic of Ippokraton Hospital, Thessaloniki, Greece (2008) and, since then, he has been working as Endocrinologist at Thessaloniki.

He worked as Research Assistant at School of Medicine of AUTH (2008-2014 and 2016-2017) and as Research Scholar at Endocrine Department of Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, Harvard Medical School (Boston, USA; 2014). He has been working as Assistant Professor of Pharmacology–Medical Research Methodology at the First Department of Pharmacology, School of Medicine, AUTH, Greece since 2019.

He has contributed to pre-graduate education of the School of Medicine (AUTH) in “Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism” (2007-2013), “Pharmacology” (since 2016) and “Clinical Pharmacology” (since 2016). He has also contributed to post-graduate education of Masters (MSc), including “Medical Research Technology” (School of Medicine, AUTH, since 2011), “Medical Research Methodology” (in English, School of Medicine, AUTH, since 2016) and “Research in Female Reproduction” (School of Medicine, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, since 2018). Furthermore, he was an invited speaker in more than 100 international and Greek congresses.

His main research interests are hepatic and bone metabolism. Stergios Polyzos has published over 350 full-length articles in peer-reviewed international medical journals. He has received 6425 citations (h-index 39) in Scopus and 9193 (h-index 44) in Google Scholar (last update May 2021). He currently serves as Associate Editor in "Metabolism, Clinical and Experimental", as Associate Editor in "Hormones" and as Reviewer in more than 80 international medical journals. He also served as Academic Editor in "Medicine" (2014-2016) and as Guest Editor of six Special Issues in the journals: "Metabolism, Clinical and Experimental", "Current Medicinal Chemistry" and "Minerva Endocrinologica".
