Dr. Ioannis Iakovou MD, MSc, PhD is associate Professor in Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, School of Medicine, head of Nuclear Medicine dpt. in University General Hospital of Thessaloniki AHEPA serving also the therapeutic department of Nuclear Medicine at PAPAGEORGIOU hospital, training physicians in therapeutic nuclear medicine and following up many patients on outpatient basis per year.

He graduated from the School of Medicine of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (1995) and specialized in Nuclear Medicine (2004) in Hippokratio hsp and Theagenio Anticancer hsp in Thessaloniki. His PhD (2003) concerns “Evaluation of the right ventricle in patients with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease by radionuclide ventriculography and <sup>99m</sup>Tc-Sestamibi perfusion imaging”

He has an MBA (2010) in "Healthcare Management" from Hellenic Open University.

He is specially educated in Therapeutic Nuclear Medicine (Theragnostics: Thyroid Cancer, PRRT, SIRT and Radiosynoviorthesis) and in Hybrid molecular imaging (SPECT/CT and PET/CT) in University of Pisa/Italy, in Universitätsklinikum des Saarlandes in Homburg/Germany, in Nuclear Medicine Department of Valais Hospital in Sion/Switzerland and in Nuclear Medicine department of German Oncology Center (European University) in Cyprus.

His undergraduate teaching fields at the Medical School covers Nuclear Medicine, Medical Physics, Radiobiology, Metabolic Bone Diseases – Radiation and Radiopharmaceutical Chemistry in School of Pharmacy. He also teaches, in postgraduate level, Nuclear Cardiology, Surgery of Thyroid / Parathyroids and Surgery of the endocrine glands.

He wrote more than 70 full papers (h-index 15) in peer review journals, 6 book chapters and more than 80 papers in international conferences' proceedings indexed in pubmed. He supervised 1 PhD, 2 diplomatic and 3 dissertations and takes part in 6 phd dissertations as a member of the supervisor committee.

He has been the leader of a research, co-investigator or external investigator in many national and international research programs (International Atomic Energy Agency, European Organization for Research and Treatment of Cancer, Novartis, ΕΣΠΙΑ, Frederick Research Center).

He is associate editor of the Radionuclide section of “Frontiers in Nuclear Medicine”. He is member of the editorial board of the “World Journal of Nuclear Medicine”, the “Diagnostics” and the “European Journal of Hybrid Imaging”.

He has been member of the Thyroid Committee in EANM since 2014 and senior advisor from the beginning of 2021. He is member of the board of Hellenic Society of Nuclear Medicine & Molecular Imaging, secretary of the Hellenic society of Salivary Glands and has been the vice president of Hellenic Society of Nuclear Medicine of Thessaloniki from 2009 to 2011. He is corresponding member of UEMS/EBNM Committee for Accreditation of NM Departments and NM Training Centres. He also works as National Representative in UEMS being also responsible of the continuing education of Hellenic society of Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging.
